Cutler Sacer was admitted to me and my heirs at a Court holden for the manor of North Walsham in the said county

hereditaments) was by a certain deed of Enfranchisement bearing date the nineteenth day of August instant and made

now or shall become seized or possessed of **And all** the said land and premises intended to be hereby conveyed to the
