# This Indenture

made the <sup>fifth</sup> ~~fourth~~ day of  
November one thousand  
nine hundred and two

Between Edward Green of North Walsham in the County of Norfolk Farmer of the one part and The North Walsham Urban District Council acting as a Rural Board (hereinafter referred to as "The Board") of the other part **Whereas** the said Edward Green being seized in customary fee simple according to the custom of the Manor of North Walsham of the hereditaments comprised in the second schedule hereto and The Board being seized in fee simple of the hereditaments comprised in the first schedule hereto have agreed to exchange the same **And whereas** the Board have at the cost but in the name of the said Edward Green enfranchised the said hereditaments specified in the second schedule hereto such enfranchisement being effected by an Indenture dated the fifteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and two and made between the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England Lords of the Manor of North Walsham of the one part and the said Edward Green of the other part **And whereas** in part performance of the said Agreement by an Indenture bearing even date with these presents and made between The Board of the one part and the said Edward Green of the other part the hereditaments comprised in the first schedule hereto have been conveyed by The Board unto and to the use of the said Edward Green in fee simple **Now this Indenture witnesseth** that in further pursuance of the said Agreement and in consideration of the conveyance made by the said Indenture bearing even date herewith the said Edward Green as Beneficial Owner hereby conveys unto the said Board the hereditaments comprised in the second schedule hereto **To hold** unto and to the use of the Board in fee simple **In witness** whereof the said Edward Green have hereunto set his hand and seal and The Board have caused their common seal to be hereunto affixed the day and year first above written.

## The first Schedule heretofore referred to

**That** piece or parcel of land situated at North Walsham aforesaid having an width from North to South of twenty six feet on theabouts and a depth from East to West of one hundred and fifty feet on theabouts which said piece or parcel of land is bounded on on towards the North and East by property retained by the Board on on towards the South by property belonging to the said Edward Green and on on towards the West by the Barton Road
