



WHAT'S HAPPENING IN YOUR AREA?

We have been busy conducting hi-visibility patrols on our coastal areas which have been increasingly busy, along with patrolling locations identified in our problem-solving plans, these have been focused around The Memorial Park in North Walsham and Gold Park in Mundesley.

We're also working with North Norfolk District Council and local residents to tackle Anti-Social Behaviour in Sadlers Wood, North Walsham. There have been numerous reports of youths starting fires and riding motorbikes through the woods. Officers are carrying out regular patrols of these woods and are liaising with local residents to report these incidents to North Walsham Safer Neighbourhood Team.

We've also been carrying out patrols outside and inside the local schools to monitor and educate drivers/ parents dropping off school children.

We have received a number of complaints regarding people riding electric scooters around the area. Visits have been made to schools for teachers to educate the pupils of the usage of these e-scooters.

Over the next month we will be out and about in North Walsham and surrounding parishes to support our communities as we approach the easing of the lockdown rules on May 17th. Numerous visits have made to the high street shops and supermarkets and public houses.

Later this month officers will be carrying out road safety checks i.e. speed and seat belt checks.

CRIME UPDATES (1st to 30th April)

Offence	Numbers	What could this entail
Arson	0	Damage caused as a result of fire.
Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)	4	Harassment, alarm or distress is caused in a non-crime incident.
Burglary business and community	0	A person commits theft in a building or structure that is not lived in.
Burglary residential	0	Entry and theft in a building or a structure that is lived in.
Criminal Damage	7	A person destroys or damages property belonging to someone else.
Domestic	5	Domestic incidents where a crime has not occurred. Parties are aged 16 or over and have been intimate partners or family members regardless of sexuality.
Hate Incident	1	Any incident where a crime has not occurred which the victim, or anyone else, thinks is based on someone's prejudice towards them because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, disability or because they are transgender.
Race or Religious aggravated public fear	0	Any crime determined to have a hate element as per above.
Possession of controlled substance	3	Unlawful possession of a drug classified in class A, B or C.
Possession of weapons	2	Unlawful possession of an article used as a weapon.
Public fear, alarm or distress	12	Public order offences e.g. from a verbal altercation to offences just short of violence.
Robbery	1	Includes a range of offences where force is used, threatened or the victim is put in fear.
Theft from a motor vehicle	0	Any item stolen that was in, on or attached to a motor vehicle.
Theft or unauthorised taking of a motor vehicle	0	Any motor vehicle including those abandoned.
Theft of pedal cycle	0	From a public place, if stolen form a shed or garage this would be a BOTD.
Theft from a person	0	Purse being taken from a handbag, or a mobile phone from a shopping basket.
