## 2. DECLARATION OF INTEREST

## 3. ELECTION OF A NEW CHAIRMAN

To elect a Chairman nominations were made by Cllr G Bull for Cllr P Spall and by Cllr B Hester for Cllr R Murphy. A ballot was carried out with Cllr P Spall receiving the most votes. Cllr P Spall accepted the position of Chair. It was **RESOLVED** 

That Cllr P Spall is appointed Chairman of the Market Committee

## 4. ELECTION OF A NEW VICE CHAIRMAN

To elect a Vice Chairman nominations were made by Cllr M Gray for Cllr S Dibben and by Cllr B Hester for Cllr R Murphy. A ballot was carried out with Cllr S Dibben receiving the most votes. Cllr S Dibben accepted the position of Vice Chair. It was **RESOLVED**

## 6. TERMS OF REFERENCE

A draft copy of the Terms of Reference had been sent to members who made the following additions and amendments - The Budget should be £6,000 annually, meetings held on a monthly basis or as required with Delegated Powers/Objectives being Market Rents, Market Entertainment, New Stalls, Road Closure dates, Car Boot Sales, Street Food Markets, Council provided Pop Up Stalls, dealing with problems and delegated matters. As proposed by Cllr G Bull and seconded by Cllr M Gray it was RESOLVED

That the Terms of Reference were agreed to include the additions and amendments as set out above and be referred to full Council

# 7. STREET FOOD MARKET

Cllr B Wright explained a Street Food Market would encourage people into the town and proposed either a Friday or Saturday evening. The street food would consist of a variety of international foods, and may be some music. The venue being around the Market Cross, pathway leading into and including the Precinct.

It was also suggested the Market Place would be the better venue even though it would require a Road Closure. It would be preferable to be held during the day on a Saturday between 12 noon until 8.00 pm as it would attract more people giving a maximum turn out. It was agreed the first Street Food Market would be a trial run so there would be no charge for a pitch to encourage as many traders as possible. From further discussions the following

As proposed by Cllr M Gray and seconded by Cllr G Bull it was RESOLVED

The Street Food Markets will:

- be managed by the Market Committee
- take place in the Market Place (with Road Closure)
- be held on a Saturday between 12 noon and 8.00 pm (stall arrival time tbc)
- have no stall charges for the first Market
- take place on a Saturday with the following dates made (provisionally):
  - 02 July 2022
  - 20 August 2022

Cllr B Wright to contact potential traders and the provider of table and chairs

# 8. CAR BOOT SALES IN THE MEMORIAL PARK

Discussion on having car boot sales in the Memorial Park to be run on a professional basis. It was suggested the ideal place would be in front of the Tennis Courts with adequate space left for access to the courts and the play areas. Checks would be made on other car boot sales in the area to find out when they are held. There would be no charge for vehicles for the first event and assuming successful then bookings and charges can be taken in advance for further

- M&I Committee to provide advertising for both events which would be on the next Agenda.
- require the purchase of stakes with tape to provide a barrier between each vehicle.
