It was discussed that police can move cars parked on the yellow zigzags, but highways cannot hand out tickets, this would require a TRO. Any other solutions require a feasibility study

It was discussed that the annual fireworks was a popular free event and it would be good to work together with the existing members of the fireworks committee to make it a TC event
