1. Nomination papers may be obtained from the offices of the Returning Officer, Electoral Services, North Norfolk District Council, Holt Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 9EN, or from the Electoral Commission website by visiting the link at <https://www.electoralcommission.org.uk/guidance-candidates-and-agents-local-government-elections-england/resources-candidates-and-agents-local-government-elections-england>

2. Nomination papers must be delivered **BY HAND** to the Returning Officer, Electoral Services, North Norfolk District Council, Holt Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 9EN on any working day, between 10am and 4pm, after the date of this notice but no later than 4 pm on Thursday, 15th August 2024.

3. If this election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 12th September 2024.

4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 11.59pm on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> August. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>

5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, by 5 pm on Wednesday, 28th August 2024. You may apply online or download a form at <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote> or contact the Electoral Registration Office direct.

6. Applications for a free Voter Authority Certificate (VAC) for anyone who does not have an accepted form of photographic Identification in order to vote at the polling station must be received by 5pm Wednesday 4th September.

7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th September 2024. You can find information and dependent upon your proxy type apply online at <https://www.gov.uk/how-to-vote/voting-by-proxy>

8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Thursday, 12<sup>th</sup> September. The incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th September. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4<sup>th</sup> September. If a person has lost/had stolen/damaged or destroyed their photo ID after the VAC application deadline of 5pm on Wednesday, 4<sup>th</sup> September has passed, an application for an emergency proxy can be made before 5pm on polling day.
