4.2 Approve Event Management Plan

It was felt that more information was need for the EMP, every Councillor was given a chance to ask Larry Gray questions to satisfy themselves of the operations. Questions included:-

- Insurance Proof of insurance needs to be provided of 5K minimum
- How will numbers be limited to 250 There will be separate in and out gates with Stewards communicating with other and only clicking people in up to a limit of 250. Council A board will be used at the entrance gate with the QR track and trace code scan. Paper forms will be available for people without the app
- People coming from other areas it will not be advertised outside the area only locally
- Sanitising All stalls/rides have their own sanitising station. Rides are fogged every other day and some every day. All Rides are also sprayed down after every use

As proposed by Cllr Murphy and seconded by Cllr Heinrich it was RESOLVED to approve, with the above measures and subject to filling in gaps on the EMP and circulating to councillors Cllrs Grav & Frver abstained
